Proposed scope of work: "The County of Socorro, State of New Mexico, on behalf of the Socorro County Board of County Commissioners, seeks sealed proposals from experienced and capable offerors that can provide architectural and project management services to site plan, design and manage construction and installation of modular classrooms at Cottonwood Valley Charter School in Socorro, New Mexico.
