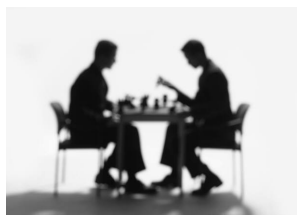
Prevention Coalition Survey For Grades 6-8
